The vendor is then required to submit *written notification* to RBS WorldPay of any changes that will affect the processing of the POS software and hardware. At that time, RBS WorldPay will determine if a certification will be required.

Additionally RBS WorldPay has provided a Receipt Report, a detailed list of observations concerning the formatting of the receipts. RBS WorldPay will not take responsibility nor will it be held accountable for any adverse effects resulting from the transaction receipts.
